

PROCEEDINGS OF 38TH STATE HIGH LEVEL CLEARANCE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 17.06.2015 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER OF KARNATAKA.

Commissioner for Industrial Development & Director of Industries & Commerce welcomed the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Hon'ble Minister for PWD, Hon'ble Minister for IT/BT, Hon'ble Minister for Infrastructure Development, Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources, Hon'ble Minister for Agriculture and other members to the meeting. Subjects were taken up for discussion as per the agenda circulated.

SUBJECT-1: PROCEEDINGS OF 37TH SHLCC MEETING

- a) Proceedings of the 37th SHLCC meeting were read and recorded.
- b) Committee noted that 37th SHLCC meeting proceedings have been circulated to all the members, relevant G.O's have been issued by C & I Department and the same were communicated to the project proponents.

SUBJECT- 2: CONSIDERATION OF NEW PROJECTS FOR APPROVAL

The Committee discussed and resolved to approve the projects with following general conditions.

- a) *The project proponents to draw water from downstream of the reservoirs with the approval of Water Resources Department.*
- b) *The project proponents shall adopt rain water harvesting, waste water recycling and water conservation facilities. Wherever applicable, zero discharge facility should be adopted.*
- c) *The iron ore / limestone based industries have to make arrangements on their own for their requirement and State Government does not guarantee supply of iron ore / limestone for the projects.*
- d) *In case of projects where power requirement is more than 50,000 KW, the project proponent should necessarily furnish the schedule of commissioning of their project and also contact the distribution utility concerned for tying up the power requirement well in advance by paying the necessary fees and obtaining necessary clearance. Secondly, wherever project proponent intends to export power, the evacuation permission should be obtained from State Load Dispatch Centre/KPTCL.*
- e) *The investors are advised to take necessary statutory clearances and plan approvals from the competent authorities before implementation of the project.*
- f) *The project proponents shall provide a plan for development of Human Resources in State and shall provide employment to local people as per Dr. Sarojini Mahishi report and as per the respective policies of the State Government.*

- g) *Wherever land acquisition through KIADB is proposed, the project proponents shall provide employment for at least one member of the family of each land losers.*
- h) *Wherever there is scope for vendor development for the project, the company shall prepare a vendor development plan, develop local vendors and procure the required inputs, components and sub assemblies from these local vendor units.*
- i) *In respect of land allotted by KIADB, the allotment shall be on lease basis as per KIADB norms.*
- j) *In respect of projects wherein lands approved and allotted by KIADB as SUC and those projects are not implemented in a time frame, the renewals relating to land issues will be subject to rules & penalties of KIADB.*
- k) *The project proponents who have purchased land U/s 109 of KLR Act for a specified project; have to obtain prior approval from SHLCC for undertaking any changes on the project.*

SUBJECT NO.3: AMENDMENTS TO PROJECTS APPROVED EARLIER

3.1 PROPOSAL OF M/S. NMDC LIMITED. TO ESTABLISH 5 MTPA INTEGRATED STEEL PLANT (2 MTPA IN THE 1st PHASE & 3 MTPA IN 2ND PHASE)" AT BELLARY DISTRICT - CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The proposal of M/s. NMDC Limited to establish "5 MTPA Integrated Steel Plant (2 MTPA in the 1st Phase & 3 MTPA in 2nd Phase)" at 5000 Acres of land to be allotted by KIADB in special industrial zone to be setup in Bellary, Hospet and Sandur Taluk by Vijayanagara Area Development Authority (VADA) Bellary Taluk & District with an investment of Rs. 9280 Crores generating an employment opportunity to about 2500 persons was approved by the 19th SHLCC meeting held on 31.08.2009.

Now, M/s.NMDC Ltd. in their letter dated 31.1.2015 has requested to transfer the project approval in favour of M/s.Karnataka Vijayanagar Steel Ltd. (which is a wholly owned subsidiary incorporated on 29.12.2014 with a purpose for development of steel plant in Karnataka) so as to facilitate setting up 3 MTPA Steel Plant in Bellary district and issue an amendment to Govt. Order No. CI 264 SPI 2009 dated 10.5.2012.

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussion approved to change the name of the project as M/s. Karnataka Vijayanagara Steel Limited, a wholly owned subsidiary of M/s. NMDC Limited subject to the condition that the subsidiary company would not be alienate the lands further to any other private party.

3.2 PROPOSAL OF M/S. XINDIA INTEGRATED STEEL PLANT TO ESTABLISH "2.5 MILLION TPA INTEGRATED STEEL PLANT WITH 250 MW CAPTIVE POWER PLANT" AT KUNIKERE & HIREBAGNAL VILLAGES, KOPPAL TALUK AND DISTRICT - AMENDMENT TO GO FOR IMPLEMENTING THE PROJECT IN PHASES

The proposal of M/s X India Steels Ltd. to establish a "2.5 Million TPA Integrated Steel Plant with 250 MW Captive Power Plant", with an investment of Rs.8735 Crores, in 1201 acres 15 guntas of land U/s 109 of KLR Act at various Sy.Nos. of Kunikere & Hirebagnal Villages, Koppal Taluk and District, was approved in the 14th SHLCC meeting held on 17.3.2008.

Further in the 36th SHLCC meeting held on 15.10.2014, the committee granted 3 years of extension of time to implement the project and 37th SHLCC meeting held on 27.03.2015, has approved 230 acres of additional land for tailing purpose with an additional investment of Rs.35.30 Cr.

Now, the company vide letter dated 30.4.2015 has informed that, they have established I Phase i.e 0.8 MTPA Pellet Plant which is operational from July, 2011. They have applied for 2nd Phase Environmental Clearance with Ministry of Environment, Forest, GOI in the year 2010 and same has been sanctioned on 4.2.2015. The delay in EC is due to iron ore mining ban in the State of Karnataka by Hon'ble Supreme Court and MOEF not considered any projects where iron ore as raw material.

Therefore, they are requesting for to amend the G.O mentioning phase wise implementation of the approved project as they could not implement the mega project in a single phase as follows:

Total Land Required : 1431 Acres (1201 + 230 - SHLCC approvals are in place)

Total Investment : Rs. 8735 crores

I phase – 0.8 MTPA Pellet Plant

Land Required : 200 Acres

Investment : Rs. 252 crores

II Phase – 1.2 MTPA Integrated Steel Plant & 160 MW Power Plant

(Delayed obtaining ENVIRONMENT CLEARANCE from MOEF due to mining ban in the state of Karnataka though it is applied in 2010. EC accorded by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India by 04th February, 2015 and project discussions in progress).

III Phase – expansion of the above to 2.5 MTPA steel Plant and 250 MW Power Plant

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussion permitted the company to implement the project in 3 phases.

3.3 PROPOSAL OF M/S. JAI BHOLE CEMENT COMBINE PVT. LTD TO ESTABLISH "2 MMTPA CAPACITY SLAG BASE GRINDING UNIT WITH 24 MW THERMAL POWER PLANT" AT KUDITHINI VILLAGE, BELLARY DISTRICT - APPROVAL OF REQUIREMENT OF ADDITIONAL LAND OF 50 ACRES AND ADDITIONAL INVESTMENT OF RS. 179 CRORES

The State High Level Clearance Committee, in its 24th meeting held on 24.1.2011 approved the project proposal of M/s. Jai Bhole Cement Combine Pvt. Ltd... to establish "2 MMTPA capacity Slag Base Grinding Unit with 24 MW Thermal Power Plant" with an investment of Rs. 321 crores in 200 acres of land at Bellary. Accordingly G.O was issued.

Further as per the request of the company land requirement was reduced to 50 acres at Kudithini Village, Bellary district to be purchased U/s 109 of KLR Act.

Now, the company vide letter dated 8.12.2014 informed that they have purchased 39.11 acres of land at Kudithini Village, Bellary District and process related land survey has started and requested for extension of time.

Further, the company vide their letter uploaded through online on 08.05.2015 informed that, they are planned to expand their project by increasing the investment from Rs. 321 Crores to Rs. 500 Crores and increasing land from 50 acres to 100 acres with additional product of OPC PPC Cement Grinding and also increase the employment opportunity from 310 to 390 persons and requested for approve the following:

- Purchase of additional land of 50 acres U/s. 109 of KLR Act from farmers which are adjacent to already acquired land of 50 acres of land in Kudithini Village.
- Additional investment of Rs. 179 crores in addition to already approved Rs.321 Crores with OPC / PPC Cement Grinding activity.
- Additional employment of 80 persons in addition to 310 persons
- Extension of time for earlier approved project by 2 years to implement the project

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussion approved the following:

- Additional land of 50 acres U/s. 109 of KLR Act which are adjacent to already approved 50 acres of land in Kudithini Village.
- Additional investment of Rs. 179 crores in addition to already approved Rs.321 Crores with OPC / PPC Cement Grinding activity.
- Additional employment of 80 persons in addition to 310 persons
- Extension of time for earlier approved project by 2 years from the date of issual of G.O to implement the project

PROPOSAL OF M/S. MPHINITE SOLUTIONS PVT. LTD TO ESTABLISH "MANUFACTURING OF PET BOTTLES, JARS AND PREFORMS" AT YADGIR INDUSTRIAL AREA,YADGIR - EXTENSION OF TIME TO IMPLEMENT THE PROJECT

The project proposal of M/s. Mphinite Solutions Pvt. Ltd. to establish "Pet Bottles, Jars and Preforms" with an investment of Rs. 489.11 Crores in 125 acres of land at Yadgir Industrial Area, Yadgir was approved in 27th SHLCC meeting held on 13.04.2012. Accordingly, Government Order was issued vide No. CI 134 SPI 2012; Dated: 21.04.2012.

The company vide its letter dated 16.4.2015 has informed that the delay in implementation of the project is due to the fact that the allotted land was under litigation and hence, they could not take possession of such land during the stipulated time. Now, the Additional Bench of Gulbarga High Court has cleared the litigation. Hence, they want to take up possession of land and implement the project at the earliest.

The area is hugely under developed and they would like to set up the basic infrastructure and accommodation for construction staff and workers. The area allotted being 125 acres needs to be fenced and leveled before any actual construction work can commence. The company has informed that all the above mentioned activities will take approximately 13-24 months to complete.

In view of the above, the company is requesting for extension of time for period of two years for implementation of the project.

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussion approved to grant of extension of time for the first time by 2 years to implement the project from the date of issual of G.O.

3.5 PROPOSAL OF M/S. BMM ISPAT LIMITED TO ESTABLISH "1 MTPA IRON ORE PELLETIZATION PLANT, 1.25 MTPA IRON ORE BENEFICIATION PLANT & 18 MW CAPTIVE POWER GENERATION" AT DANAPURA VILLAGE, HOSPET TALUK, BELLARY DISTRICT - TO ACQUIRE AND ALLOT LEFT OUT LAND

The project proposal of M/s. BMM Ispat Limited., to establish "1 MTPA Iron Ore Pelletization Plant, 1.25 MTPA Iron Ore Beneficiation Plant & 18 MW Captive Power Generation" with an investment of Rs. 257 crores in 314.43 acres of land at various Sy. Nos. of Danapura Village, Hospet Taluk, Bellary District was approved in the 3rd SHLCC meeting held on 03.03.2005 and the Government Order was issued.

Company vide its letter dated. 19.01.2015 has informed that, out of 314.43 acres of land recommended for acquisition and allotment for the project from KIADB, 196.48 is private land and 117.95 is Government Land. KIADB has so far acquired and allotted 196.48 acres of private land and 103.74 acres of Government land out of 117.95 acres. But, 14.21 acres of Government land in Sy. No. 16A1/1E and 48A/24 of the above village is left out and requested to hand over the same. They have further informed that, their steel plant is already in operation with all statutory clearances.

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussion directed KIADB to handover the balance land of 14.21 acres which is part of the land approved for the project earlier.

3.6 PROPOSAL OF M/S. GOEL GANGA REALTY PVT. LTD. TO ESTABLISH "IT, ITES/E-OFFICE SPACE PARK & MULTI DWELLING MIX DEVPT. " AT DEVANAHALLI TALUK, BANGALORE RURAL DISTRICT - CANCELLATION OF APPROVAL

The project proposal of M/s. Goel Ganga Reality Pvt Ltd to establish a "IT, ITES / E – Office Space Park" with an investment of Rs. 165.21 Crores in 10 acres of land at Bangalore IT Park, Devanahalli Taluk, Bangalore Rural District was approved in the 25th SHLCC meeting held on 14.07.2011 and GO was issued.

Subsequently, in the 27th SHLCC meeting held on 13.04.2012, it was approved for change of activity from "IT, ITES / E – Office Space Park" to "IT / ITES, E Office Space Hardware Office Space, Residential, Commercial Space, Common Facility Block and Mixed Use Development" and the amended GO was issued.

Now, the company has submitted online application on 22.12.2014 requesting for extension of time for a period of 3 years to implement the project. It is stated in the letter that, the company is keen to implement the project and the application for allotment of land to KIADB was not filed as there was no progress of infrastructure facilities in the proposed project location.

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussions decided to cancel the approval given for this project.

PROPOSAL OF M/S. KINETIX SOLUTIONS PVT LTD TO ESTABLISH "TRAILER WAGON MOUNTED MOBILE STATIC LAUNCHER & CONTROL ELECTRONICS" AT DEVANAHALLI BANGALORE RURAL DISTRICT - CORRECTION IN GOVERNMENT ORDER

37th SHLCC held on 27.3.2015 has approved the project proposal of M/s.Kinetix Solutions Pvt. Ltd. to establish "Trailer Wagon Mounted Mobil Static Launcher & Control Electronics" in 10 acres of land at Aerospace Park, Devanahalli, Bangalore Rural District. Now the Company has requested this office to make necessary correction in the GO for the location as Aerospace SEZ instead of Aerospace Park, Devanahalli, Bangalore Rural District.

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussions approved the request of the company for correction in name of the Industrial Area as "Aerospace SEZ, Devanahalli" instead of "Aerospace Park, Devanahalli" in the GO issued.

PROPOSAL OF M/S. SHIVSHAKTHI SUGARS LTD TO ESTABLISH "7500 TCD SUGAR PLANT, 12 MW CO-GEN PLANT AND 30 KLPD ETHANOL PLANT " AT SOUNDATTI, YADRAV POST RAIBAGH TALUK, BELGAUM DISTRICT - ADDITIONAL INVESTMENT AND ENHANCEMENT OF PRODUCTION

The project proposal of the company was approved in 8th SHLCC meeting held on 23.02.2007 to establish "3000 TCD Sugar Plant, 12 MW Co-Gen Plant and 30 KLPD Ethanol Plant" with an investment of Rs. 106.849 Crores in 77 acres 25 guntas of land at Soundatti Yadrav Post, Raibagh Taluk, Belgaum District.

The company further expanded the production capacity of Sugar Plant from "3000 TCD to 7500 TCD, Co-Gen from 12 MW to 45 MW and Ethanol Plant from 30 KLPD to 120 KLPD" which was approved in 27th SHLCC meeting held on 13.04.2012 and G.O was issued vide G.O.No. CI 133 SPI 2012, Bangalore dated 21.4.2012 and Corrigendum on 24.7.2012.

The company has informed that due to market demand and availability of cane in the reserved area, the company has planned to expand the sugar plant capacity from "7500 TCD to 10,000 TCD and Co-Gen Plant from 45 MW to 60 MW" and requested SHLCC to approve the Sugar Plant capacity to be increased from 7500 TCD to 10,000 TCD and Co-generation of power from 45 to 60 MW with an investment of Rs.367.47 Crores in existing land. The subject was discussed in 37th SHLCC meeting held on 27.3.2015. The Committee after detailed discussions directed to examine the proposal and to submit on file for approval to Hon'ble Chief Minister and Chairman of SHLCC.

The company has taken IEM from GOI for enhanced capacity vide No. 3078/ SIA /IMO/2006 dated 8.6.2006 and 12.5.2015.

Subsequently, the subject was discussed in 18th Land Audit Committee held on 22.5.2015 and decided to obtain opinion of the Commissioner Cane Development on availability of sugarcane to meet the additional requirement envisaged in the expansion plan before submitting the file for approval.

Cane Commissioner vide its letter No.DSK/DEV/3/2015-16 dated 26.5.2015 has recommended to consider the expand capacity of M/s Shivshakthi Sugars Ltd. from 7500 TCD to 10,000 TCD with a condition that they should procure the required cane for their expanded capacity by developing cane area from their allotted reserved area only.

Commissioner for Cane Development and Director of Sugar was requested to furnish the following details:

- (a) Payment of arrears to farmers
- (b) Availability of Cane for the expansion proposal of the company.

The Commissioner for Cane Development & Director of Sugars, who was present in the meeting, informed that the company has been requested to develop cane in the area allotted to them.

Decision of SHLCC: The committee after detailed discussions observed that there are huge arrears to be paid to the farmers. In view of this, the committee conditionally approved the project subject to the payment of cane arrears to the farmers by the company.

- To expand the crushing capacity from 7500 TCD to 10000 TCD.
- To expand Co-Gen plant capacity from 45 MW to 60 MW.
- To invest additional amount of Rs.367.47 crores in the existing land.
- To undertake expansion by procuring the required cane by developing Cane area from their allotted reserved area only.
- Company to encourage and participate for adoption of drip irrigation system by cane growers in allotted Cane Zone.

3.9 PROPOSAL OF M/S. INDIAN CANE POWER LTD. TO EXPAND FROM : 12,000TCD TO 24,000 TCD SUGAR PLANT & 78MW TO 83 MW COGEN POWER" IN UTTUR VILLAGE, MUDHOL TALUK, BAGALKOT DISTRICT – EXPANSION PROPOSAL.

In the 5th SHLCC meeting held on 10-10-2005 project proposal to establish 2500 TCD sugar factory was approved. Expansion proposal from 5,000TCD to 12,000 TCD & Cogen from 18MW to 78MW was approved in 31 SHLCC meeting held on 17-06-2013. Go was issued on 17-07-2013.

Present proposal is for enhancement of sugar cane crushing capacity from 12000TCD to 24000 TCD & to expand 78MW to 83 MW Cogen with an investment of Rs 350 Cr in 50 acres of additional land in various Sy.Nos. of Uttur Village, Mudhol Taluk, Bagalkot District to be acquired and allotted by KIADB as SUC on consent basis. Earlier company has purchased 220 acres of land u/s 109 of KLR Act, after obtaining consent from all the land owners.

Company is seeking to purchase additional land of 50 acres (the details of 24 acres 18 Guntas in sy nos 118/1,107/3,97/3,118/3 furnished) for Bagasse storage & raw material storage.

DIPP, GOI has issued IEM dated 14-5-2015 for expansion capacity of 24000 TCD crushing of Sugar.

The company has uploaded letter dated 15.6.2015 issued from Cane Commissioner to the Secretary to Government, C & I Department regarding in principle administrative approval for the expansion crushing capacity from 12000 to 24000 TCD sugar with conditions that the company shall not ask for additional cane area and to cultivate and develop required additional sugar cane in the allotted Cane area and to submit statutory approval / NOC from Karnataka Udyog Mitra and KSPCB.

The company has furnished RTC /mutation copies for 24 acres 18 guntas of land in Sy.Nos. 118/1,107/3, 97/3,118/3A of Uttur Village, Mudhol Taluk, Bagalkot District and yet to furnish consent letters from farmers / land owners for the requirement of additional land.

The company is seeking following approvals.

- 1) To increase Sugar Crushing capacity from 12000 TCD to 24000 TCD & Co Gen from 78MW to 83 MW with an additional investment of Rs 350 Cr .
- 2) Additional land of 50 acres (the details of 24 acres 18 Guntas in sy nos 118/1,107/3, 97/3,118/3A of Uttur Village, Mudhol Taluk, Bagalkot District is furnished) to be acquired & allotted by KIADB as SUC on consent basis.

Decision of SHLCC


