



Karnataka is one of the most preferred destination for Industrial investments. However ease of doing business by way of simplification and streamlining the procedures and guidelines for obtaining various clearances/approvals, is one of the main demands of industries. One of the strategies being worked out by the C&I Department is to introduce a common platform/e-portal to facilitate the project proponents to obtain all the required clearances/approval-through single e-portal only rather than meeting various government officers. CIRCULAR

Sub:- Guidelines for multipurpose use of water-reg.


In continuation to the Circular issued vide No. WRD 29 KBN 2008 dated.9/12/2009, further Water Resources Department will set the following priorities and issue the following guidelines for allotment of water to the industries.

1. The water supply for irrigation to the lands will be accorded top priority and prime importance. Industries shall be allocated the requirement of water without in any way causing adverse impact on the irrigation requirements. This is necessary to be complied so that a farmer right to irrigation is maintained.
2. The availability of water that can be allocated to the industrial sector can be assessed from time to time either by an internal committee constituted by the Water Resources Department or in case of special circumstances it may also obtain an expert committee's report.
3. In the case of industries which have been allotted water and have failed to utilize the water, it is proposed to cancel the allotment given earlier to such industry after giving an opportunity by serving a notice to the industry and obtaining explanation/reply. After obtaining the reply and opinion of the Commerce and Industries Department, the allotment given will be examined and the permission already given will be cancelled reserving the right to the industry to approach the Government afresh as and when the said industry come to the stage of utilizing the water.
4. Savings out of unutilized planned achkats due to geographical constraints, conjunctive use of ground water, optimum regeneration achieved by desalination of the land and reclaiming the waterlogged areas shall be taken into consideration while assessing the quantity of water that would be made available for industrial allocation.
5. No industry shall be allowed to draw its requirement of water from any reservoir so that the irrigation interest of the farmers is not affected.
6. The lifting of water from the rivers will be permitted only from the downstream of the reservoirs and only during monsoon. To facilitate lifting of water a small pondage is to be created if need be.

7. The allocation of water in Krishna basin due to Godavari diversion will also be taken into consideration for future allocation.
8. Mandatory storage of non-monsoon requirement need to be created by any industry that is permitted to draw the water. The industries shall at the same time make use of the ground water and reduce depending on surface water. Allotment of water made initially to the industry is liable to be revised depending upon the usage of ground water. The industries are also required to use modern technologies so that the water saving is ensured.] A
9. The Department has the right to restrict or stop the release of water to the industry in order to provide water to irrigation.



PROCEEDING OF GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: - Guidelines for multipurpose use of water-reg.

Preamble: -

The Department of Commerce & Industries has been forwarding the applications received by them from various industries for allocation of water for industrial purposes from time to time. The water Resources Department vide its Circular No. WRD 29 KBN 2008 dated 9/12/2009 has listed certain conditions under which allocation of water to the industrial sector and Thermal Power Projects can be considered. These guidelines are basically for an initial in-principle clearance being given for allotment of water without getting into details of source of availability of water. Now it is felt that, as the demand has been increasing more and more, the source of water availability and water allotment needs to be considered together. Therefore, in addition to these guidelines, it is proposed further that the Water Resources Department need to follow and set certain priorities and follow guidelines for future allocation of water to the industrial sector.

Therefore, it is decided by the government to constitute a committee to examine the proposal received requesting for the allotment of water from the industries with respect to the location of the source of water and the existing demand at the particular location and to fulfill the demands of the industries.





The Chairman welcomed all the officers to the meeting. The Chairman, emphasized on the allotment of water to the industries by which WRD would facilitate the progress of industries in the state. He enquired about the exact demand of water for the industries and the authenticity of demand and assessing the quantity at the source of water etc.

The Secretary to Government, WRD briefed that as per Master Plan 2002, out of total allocation of 734.00 TMC to Karnataka in Krishna Basin, 0.50 TMC has been earmarked for industrial use. In Upper Krishna Project out of 173 TMC, 0.125 TMC is earmarked for industrial use and in Hippargi project out of total quantity of 12.10 TMC, 0.46 TMC is earmarked for industry and drinking water. Therefore for industrial use 0.23 TMC could be considered.

Further it is also contemplated that in the Bachwat Award, for industrial use out of the diverted quantity 2.50 % should be considered as the consumptive use. Thereby, the total 0.855 TMC consumptive quantity earmarked for industrial use works out to 34.20 TMC diverted quantity which could be allotted for industries in Krishna Basin directly from the rivers/ reservoirs and other sources. So far water permissions given to the industries in Krishna Basin is 32.54 TMC for about 100 industries.

The total demand of water to the industries post GIM 2011 as compiled in Sri.D.N. Desai's committee report upto Oct.2010 works out to 48.60 TMC of

which 43.66 TMC is in Krishna Basin, 2.5TMC in Cauvery Basin, 0.45 TMC in Godavari basin, 0.35 TMC in Pennar Basin, 0.4TMC in Palar Basin and 1.25TMC in West Flowing Rivers.

The Chairman made some important observations and thereby committee arrived at the following decisions:

- 1) It could be observed that the permission given to industries with respect to allocation of water in Krishna Basin is almost equal. Water has now become a scarce resource and should be used judiciously by the industries.
- 2) For the allotments/permissions already given to the industries, the concerned Chief Engineer has to examine the utilization of water by the industries under his jurisdiction and should issue notice to such industries to furnish the water utilization along with the flow meter readings during the last 3 years and the details of water rates collected from these industries. All the chief engineers shall report the same to the Government within a week's time, and the concerned Deputy Secretary will compile the information and report the same to the committee in its next meeting.
- 3) It is also observed that the demand made by the industries is not assessed or certified by C & I Department. Therefore all the proposals will be sent back to the C & I Department to get their certification/consent.
- 4) Industries Department has to examine whether the demand of water made by the factory/company/industry is reasonable/justifiable and C & I Department has to assess and certify the demand in each case.
- 5) C & I Department should furnish the list of black listed companies to Water Resources Department immediately, if they have done the same.
- 6) The allotment and use of water by the industries will not affect the irrigation.

- 7) The allotment of water would be made mainly from the run off of the rivers during monsoon period only, so that the industries can make their own storage arrangements to manage their requirement of water in the non-flow months.
- 8) For new proposals, the Chief Engineer has to examine the water source and the availability of water in that source taking into account all the previous permissions given in that source. The Chief Engineer has to recommend clearly whether the requirement is genuine and request can be considered.
- 9) The Chief Engineer WRDO should verify the balance availability of water in that particular source, basin & sub basin and recommend to the Government. JB
- 10) The consumptive use of water in respect of "Mini Hydel scheme" is stated to be nil, hence the committee decided to allocate the water to such proposals, and recommended that these proposals can be straight away submitted to the Hon'ble Minister for his approval.
- B [11) Committee decided not to allow water to industries from reservoirs as per the WRD circular dated. 5/7/2011 and all such proposals shall be rejected with a request to the concerned industry to examine the alternate taking of water sources. JB
- 12) It was decided that, every 2 years at the time of renewal the water permission given has to be reviewed based on the water rate collected & compliance to the conditions contemplated in the agreement between the industry & the Department/Nigam. Bi-annual renewal of the license made as a condition.
- 13) The Chief Engineers shall ensure that the exact utilization of water by the allotted industries is measured and accounted for.
- 14) Though allotment of water to industries could be made on first come first basis, however preference could be given to such of the industries whose infrastructure is ready and to industries which have obtained allotment of land, financial sanctions, power sanction, environmental

clearance, coal lease permit etc., so that the economic development of the state is taken into consideration.


15) All Chief Engineers to issue show cause notice within 15 days to all the industries under their jurisdiction.

i) For those industries, who have not utilized any quantity of the allotted quantum of water, and submit their explanation to the committee for its consideration.

ii) For the industries, who have utilized partial quantity out of the total allotted quantum of water, the explanation should be submitted to the committee for its consideration.

16) C&I department to examine & standardize the requirement of water of various type of industries based on new technology, conjunctive use, recycling. Also the C&I Department/Energy Department should certify the requirement of water to the industry/Thermal Power Plant (Coal based, Gas based, Bio-mass based including the cogeneration in sugar factories).
